The District of Columbia Chapter of the Federal Bar Association is soliciting nominations for the 50<sup>th</sup> annual Justice Tom C. Clark Award for Outstanding Government Attorney. This is a wonderful opportunity to recognize and encourage excellence in your Agency.

The Justice Tom C. Clark Award is presented in recognition of the outstanding accomplishments by lawyers in the career service of the Federal Government in the D.C. metropolitan area or of the Government of the District of Columbia. The award honors Justice Tom C. More than 80 agencies and departments are solicited for nominations. **All nominations must be received by Friday May 28, 2010.** A distinguished committee of federal judges will make the final selection and announce its decision in July 2010. The award will be presented at a reception to be held at a date to be mutually determined by the Federal Bar Association and the agency of the recipient.

In support of each nomination, please submit a biographical overview along with a brief cover letter explaining how the nominee's career service has contributed to the Federal or District of Columbia governments. **Selection Criteria and Process:**

The selection committee reviews the qualifications of the nominees in light of the purpose and nomination criteria of the Justice Tom C. Clark Award. The Justice Tom C. Clark Award is presented in recognition of the outstanding accomplishments by lawyers in the career service of the Federal Government in the D.C. Metropolitan area or of the Government of the District of Columbia. The award honors Justice Tom C. Clark, a former Federal Bar Association President (national), for his distinguished career as a government attorney who served as Attorney General of the United States, Associate Justice of the U.S. Supreme Court and as the first Director of the Federal Judicial Center.

In soliciting nominees, we ask the federal agencies to nominate individuals who fulfill one of the following criteria for the Justice Tom C. Clark Award:

1. General accomplishments – a nominee may be qualified by outstanding legal ability, scholarship and performance over a sustained period even though the specific accomplishments are not related;

Or

2. Specific accomplishments – a nominee may be qualified by virtue of a specific accomplishment which results in significant benefit to the government or to the legal profession and which constitutes a contribution to the development of public law. The accomplishment(s) of the nominee should be reasonably related in time to the year preceding the nomination.

**Submission:**

Please include a biographical overview along with a cover letter with agency contact information. The cover letter should explain how the nominee's career service has contributed to the Federal or District of Columbia governments.
