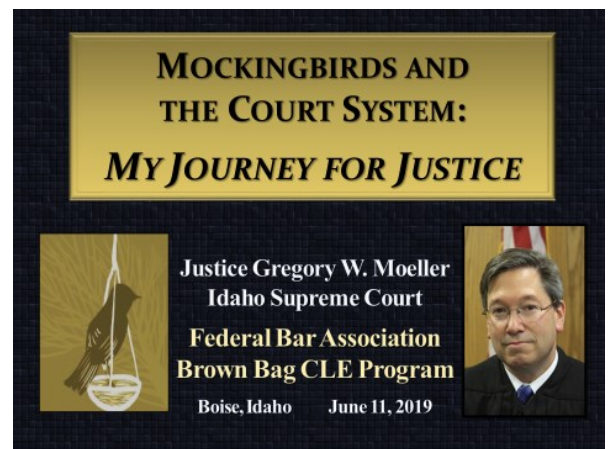

Brown Bag CLE: *Mockingbirds and the Court System: My Journey for Justice*

Justice Gregory W. Moeller discusses the role that the book, *To Kill a Mockingbird*, played in his life by inspiring him as a boy to pursue a career in law, and to later take on a murder case with many similarities to the trial in the book.

The presentation will delve into the forensic evidence that ultimately led to U.S. District Judge B. Lynn Winmill granting a writ of habeas corpus and ordering a new trial after the defendant had spent 15 years in prison. The story comes full circle as it recounts how Harper Lee, the

author of *To Kill a Mockingbird*, learned about the murder case and reached out to Justice Moeller.
