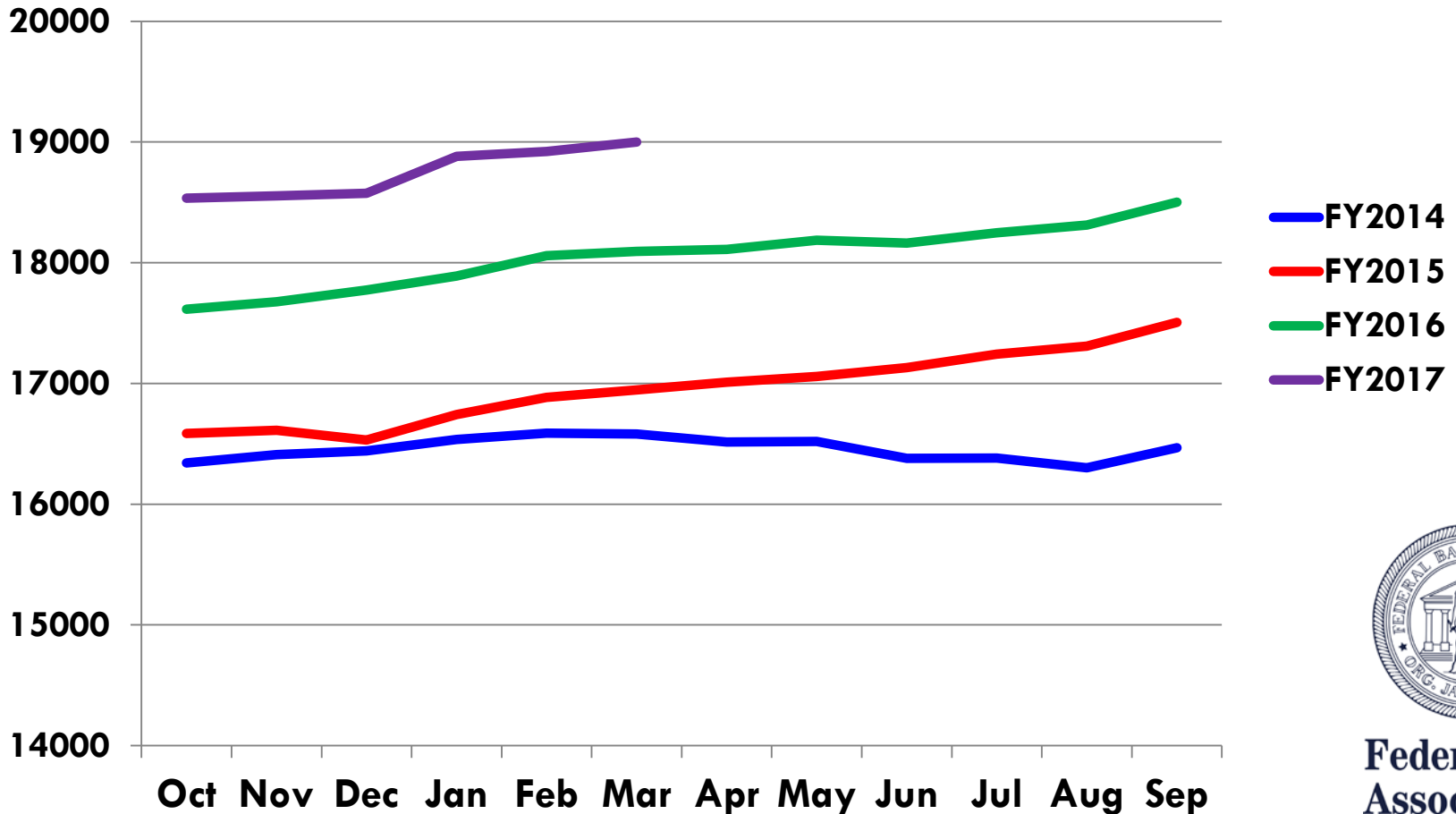

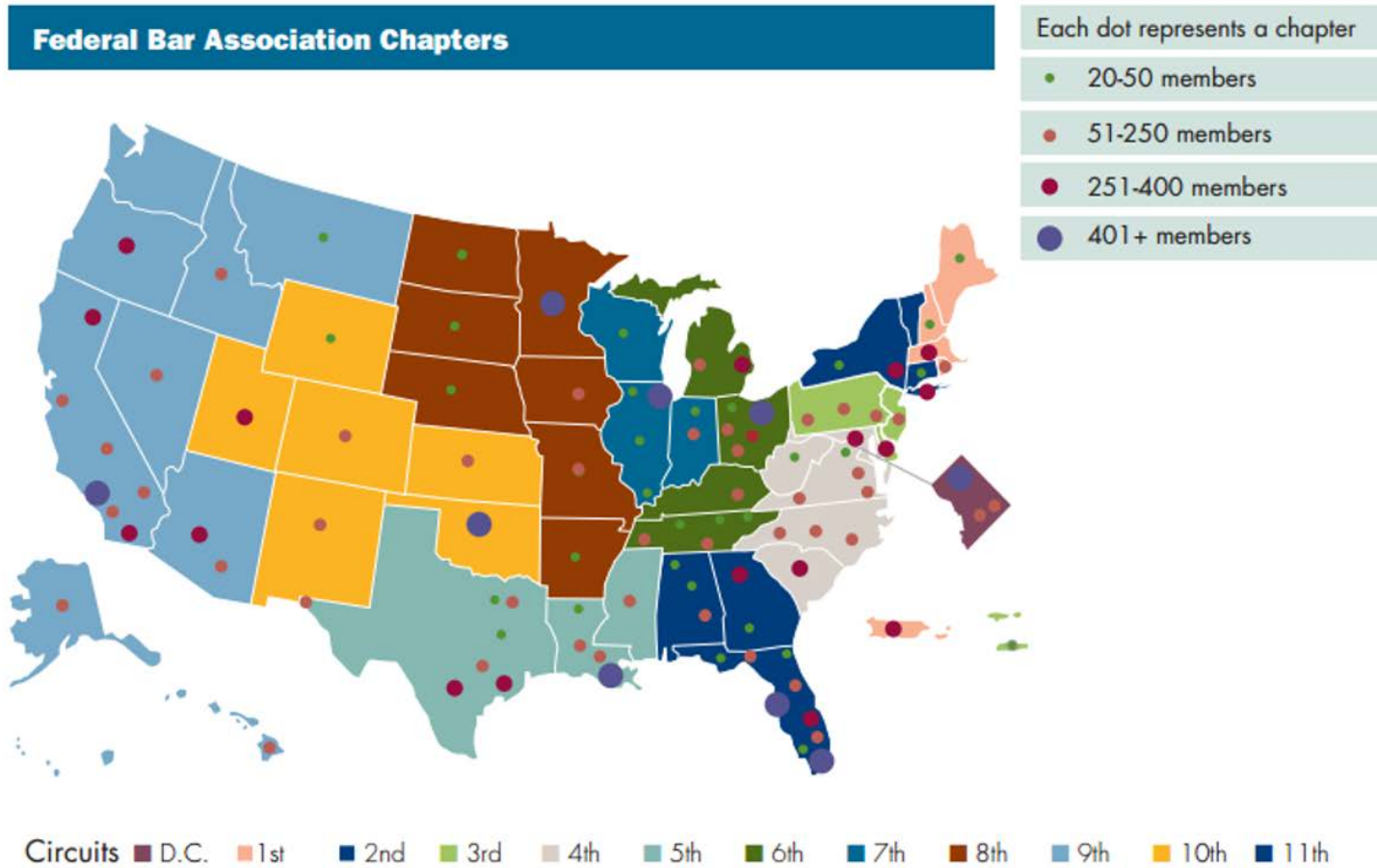
Monthly Membership Counts

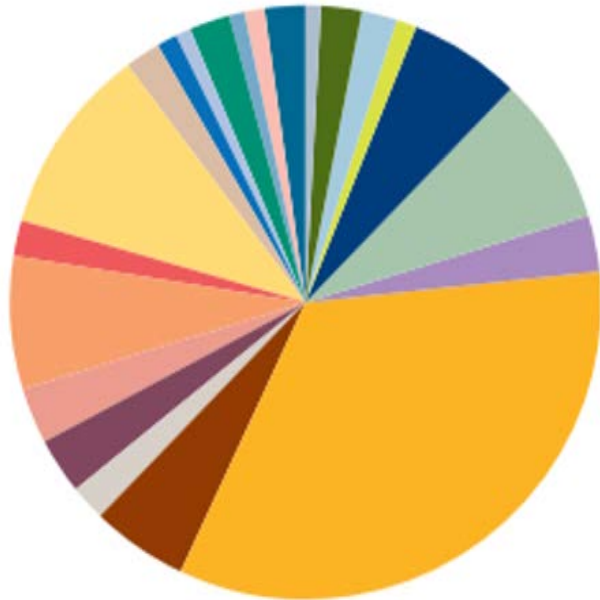

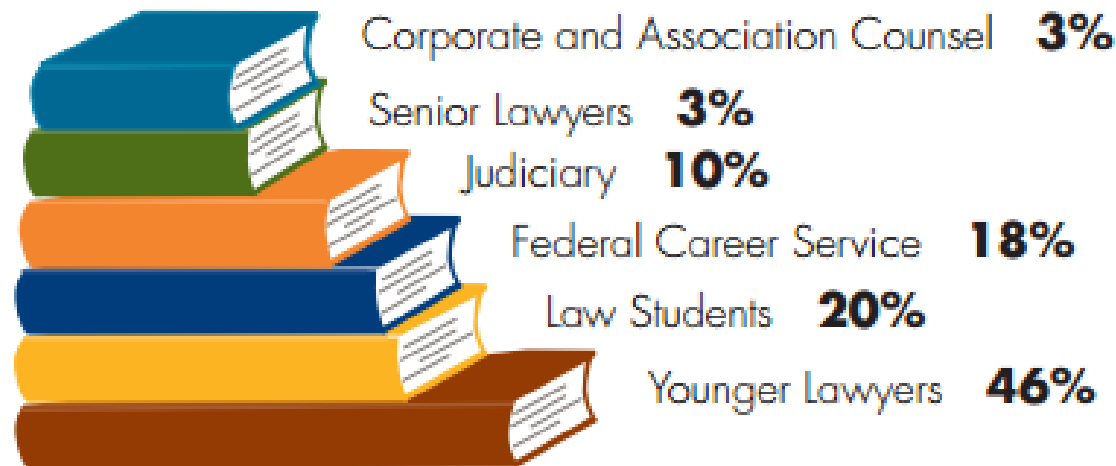

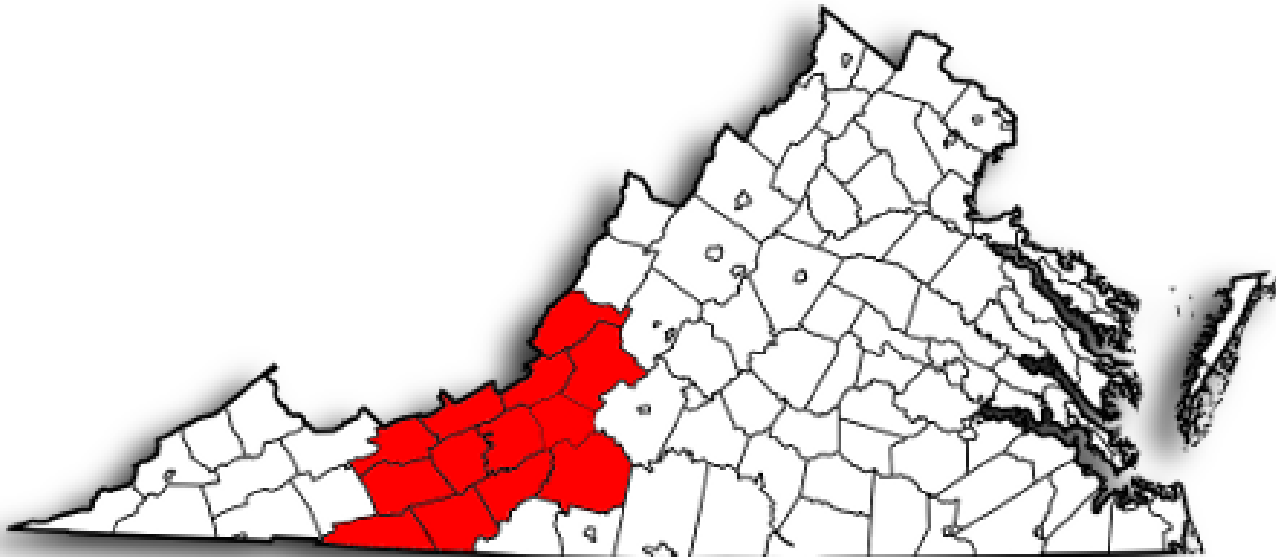
Career Divisions

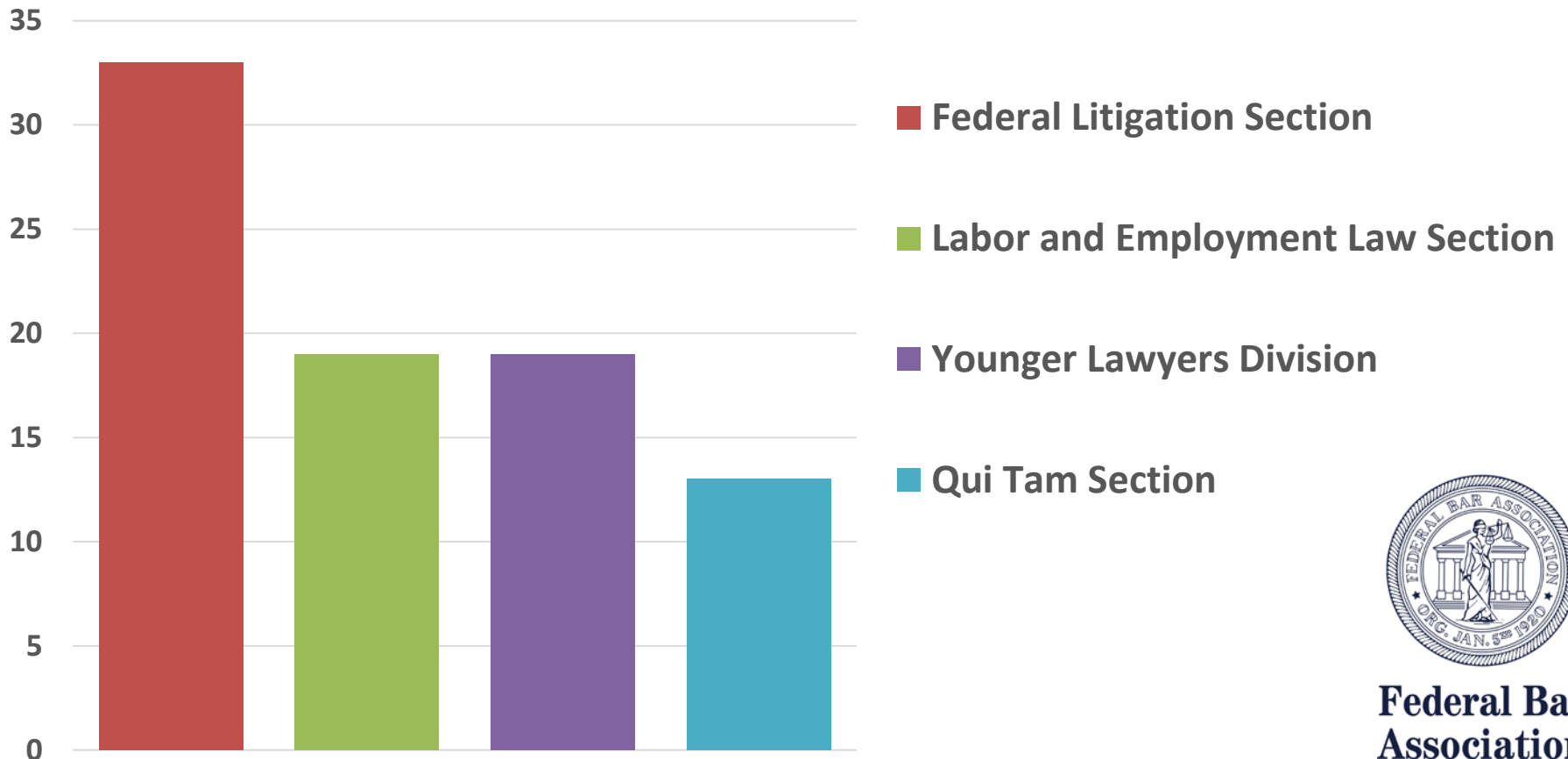


