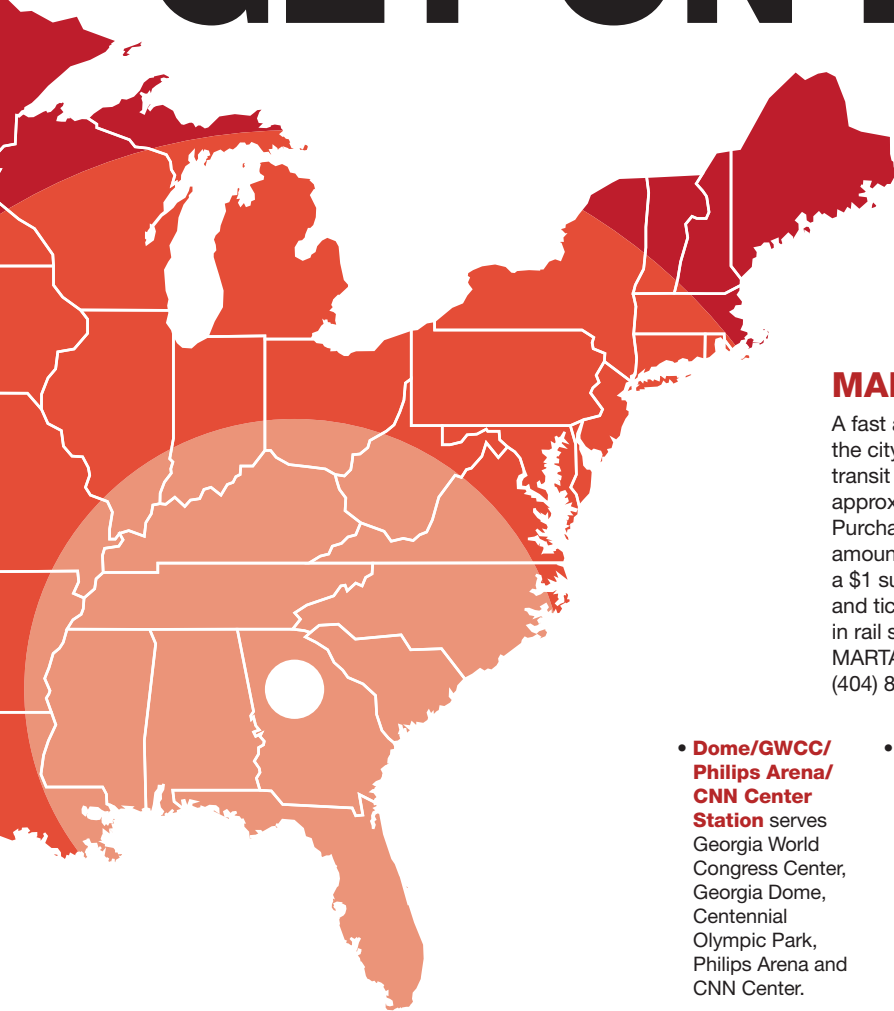
HARTSFIELD-JACKSON ATLANTA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

- More than 2,500 average flights daily

AMERICA'S MOST ACCESSIBLE CITY

- Atlanta is accessible via **Interstates 20, 75, and 85** and **Georgia 400**. I-285 forms a beltway around the city.
- The **Buckhead Uptown Connection (The Buc)** provides free service throughout the Buckhead business district. Stops include the Lenox and Buckhead MARTA stations, Lenox Square and Phipps Plaza, various restaurants and hotels and numerous office buildings. - **AMTRAK** offers service to New Orleans, New York and points in between.

MARTA

A fast and affordable way to navigate the city, MARTA is the ninth-largest transit system in the U.S., providing approximately 430,000 passenger trips a day in Atlanta. Purchase a reloadable Breeze Card (\$2) and add the desired fare amount (\$2.50 per single ride). Breeze tickets also are available for a \$1 surcharge plus the \$2.50 fare for a single ride. Breeze Cards and tickets can be purchased at Breeze vending machines located in rail stations or MARTA Ride Stores. You can also order the MARTA Visitor Pass in advance. "Want to learn more? - **Dome/GWCC/ Philips Arena/ CNN Center Station** serves Georgia World Congress Center, Georgia Dome, Centennial Olympic Park, Philips Arena and CNN Center.
- **Peachtree Center Station** serves World of Coca-Cola, Center for Civil & Human Rights, College Football Hall of Fame and Chick-fil-A Fan Experience, AmericasMart Atlanta, downtown convention hotels, Centennial Olympic Park, Georgia Aquarium and The Children's Museum of Atlanta.
- **Arts Center Station** serves Woodruff Arts Center/High Museum of Art, Center for Puppetry Arts, Atlanta Botanical Garden and Atlantic Station.
- **Buckhead and Lenox Stations** serve Buckhead hotels, restaurants, Lenox Square and Phipps Plaza.
- MARTA's #110 bus route, "**The Peach**," connects downtown to Buckhead via Peachtree Street, offering a way to enjoy restaurants, shopping and entertainment along Atlanta's most famous thoroughfare.



ATLANTA STREETCAR

The **Atlanta Streetcar** is the city's newest form of transportation. They operate on rail and offer a safe, convenient means of connecting some of Atlanta's most popular sites. They make 12 stops along a 2.7-mile loop. Single trip fare is \$1; multiple trip passes are available.



OTHER TRANSPORTATION MODES

In addition to taxi service and major car rental companies, attendees can use **SuperShuttle** for convenient and economical van service between the airport and hotels. **Uber** connects riders with drivers via a mobile app.
