CHAPTER CIVICS LIAISON

FBA National encourages all chapters to appoint a Civics Liaison.

The civics liaison will serve as the point-of-contact for the chapter with FBA Headquarters and the Community Service and Outreach Committee in promoting civics-related activities, as well as assist in the distribution of civics materials to the chapter and its members and stakeholders.

A focus of the liaison will be facilitation of meetings between federal judges and middle and high school students.

This position is intended to enliven and strengthen a chapter, not create more work.

The Liaison could assist, as appropriate, in:

- Organizing meetings between federal judges with middle and high school students
- Promoting and distributing civics-education resources. Materials can be found on www.fedbar.org/civics .
- Promoting the FBA Civics Essay Contest geared toward middle and high school students
- Supporting and celebrating the importance of Constitution Day & Citizenship Day (September 17)
- Other duties as assigned by the chapter to promote civics engagement

The Community Service and Outreach Committee will periodically host teleconferences for chapter civics liaisons and chapter presidents on pertinent issues and developments.
