

LABOR & EMPLOYMENT SECTION GRANT

Grant criteria for a program to facilitate and fund FBA and Labor & Employment Section membership for a recipient for each of 4 classes of applicants:

1. Government Attorney
2. Private Attorney
3. New Attorney (practicing 5 years or less)
4. Third Year Law Student
5. In-house Attorneys representing non-profit [501(c)(3)] organizations

PURPOSE:

To increase the membership of the Federal Bar Association and Labor and Employment Section by providing funding for membership in both to attorneys who are not currently members.

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicant must meet all requirements for FBA membership:
 - A. The person must be admitted to the practice of law before a federal court or court of record in any of the several states, commonwealths, territories, or possessions of the United States or in the District of Columbia, or
 - B. The person must be a law student actively enrolled in an accredited law school and not admitted to the practice of law before a federal court or a court of record in any of the several states, commonwealths, territories, or possessions of the United States or in the District of Columbia.
2. Applicant must be one of the following:
 - A. Government Attorney
 - B. Private Attorney
 - C. New Attorney (practicing 5 years or less)
 - D. Third Year Law Student
 - E. In-house Attorneys representing non-profit [501(c)(3)] organizations
3. Applicant has not been a member of the Federal Bar Association and/or the Labor & Employment Section previously.
4. Applicant is either practicing, or has an interest in the area of labor and employment law.
5. Applicant agrees to actively participate in the Labor & Employment Section activities and join at least one committee

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applicant shall submit a written description of his or her accomplishments, including how he or she meets the criteria above, on or before June 1. The application shall include the applicant's contact information--name, address, telephone number and email.

Applicants may also be nominated by any current member of the FBA in good standing. The application should also include the contact information for the person making the nomination.

The application should not exceed three pages. The selectee(s) will be notified within thirty (30) days of June 1.
