

2026 Health Law Section Scholarship

The Health Law Section is pleased to announce its annual scholarship for a law student to attend the **FBA Annual Meeting and Convention** in the autumn. We invite law students to submit essay applications for scholarship consideration.

Eligibility:

1. Applicants must be full-time or part-time law students currently seeking a Juris Doctor (JD) or a Master of Laws (LLM) at an accredited law school.
2. Applicants must be law student associates of the FBA.
3. Applicants must submit a short essay (up to 600 words) about their interest in practicing health law.

Entry Process: Essay applications may be submitted until June 15th. Submissions received after 11:59 p.m. (PT) on June 15th will not be considered. The applicant selected as the scholarship recipient agrees to participate in an interview for the Health Law Section's newsletter and also permits the Health Law Section to publish the recipient's application essay in the Section's newsletter. Winners & Prizes: One applicant will be selected by the Health Law Section's scholarship review committee comprised of current and immediate past officers of the Health Law Section. The FBA will notify the selected scholarship recipient by July 15, 2026. Scholarship includes up to \$1,500.00 for travel and registration expenses related to attending the Annual Meeting; proof of purchase is required for reimbursement. The **2026 Annual Meeting will be held in Richmond, Virginia on September 18th through September 19th**. Evaluation: Applications will be evaluated based on the (1) depth and substance of the essay and (2) the applicant's commitment to health law as evidenced by or through coursework, professional experience, and participation in health law activities.
