The event will be held on **May 22, 2025 at 5 p.m. Central**. Steve Wilson of City Wine Market in Lawrence, Kansas will be presenting:

Rosé All Day Tasting

Description: Hues of pink are back in style. This historically misunderstood wine has returned to its rightful place, at the pool, at the beach and on the brunch, lunch and dinner table. Whether you rosé or bro-sé, this completely refreshing, highly quaffable “summer-in-a-glass” has something for everyone.

Suggested Tasting Bottles:

1. Purchase one bottle of Rosé from the region of Provence, France. Producers to look for: Maison Saint AIX, Chateau d’Esclans ‘Whispering Angel’, Miraval, Commanderie de la Bargemone. Select 2023 or 2024 vintage.
2. Purchase one bottle of Rosé of Pinot Noir from California (particularly Sonoma or Santa Barbara) or Willamette Valley, Oregon. Producers to look for: Pali Wine Co., Sanford, Belle Glos, Lange Estate, Stoller, King Estate. Select 2023 or 2024 vintage.

Possible Food Accompaniments for the Bottles:

1. Humus and grilled pita; grilled vegetables; chilled shrimp with cocktail sauce, lemon aioli; Spanish conservas, like tuna or hake, packed in olive oil; fresh melon, peaches; cheeses like brie, goat and feta; cured meats like saucisson sec, jamon, prosciutto; and country pate.
2. Cured Salmon, lox or gravlax; sushi rolls; soft cheeses like Burrata; cured meats from pork and duck; quiche; and fresh strawberries, raspberries, watermelon.
