In the past decade, the number of openly LGBT lawyers has more than **doubled**.

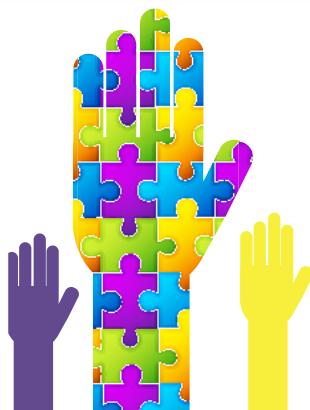


57%

of the reported openly LGBT attorneys are accounted for by just four cities: New York, Washington, D.C., Los Angeles, and San Francisco.

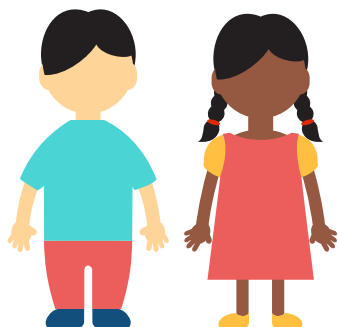

Associates with disabilities account for just over 0.39% of associates in law firms.

Only 2.5% of all partners are minority women.



Employed LGBT law school graduates were far more likely to be working for a public interest organization compared to employed graduates as a whole, and less likely to be working at a law firm.

After graduation, minorities were less likely to be employed full-time than non-minorities.
