### Networking

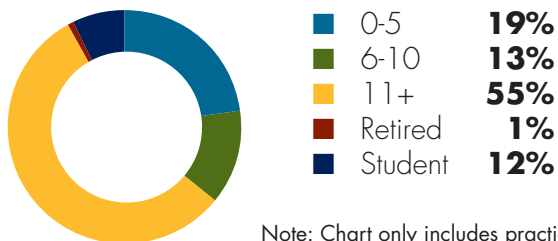

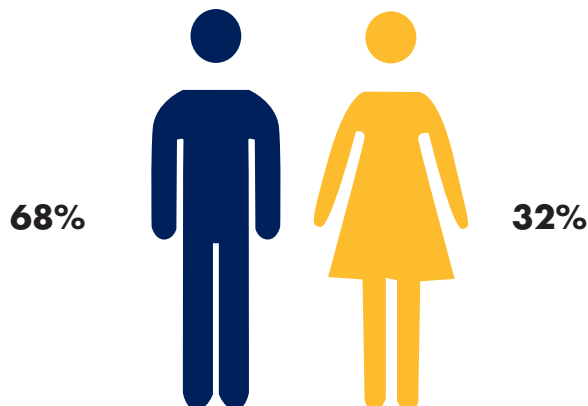

## Years in Practice

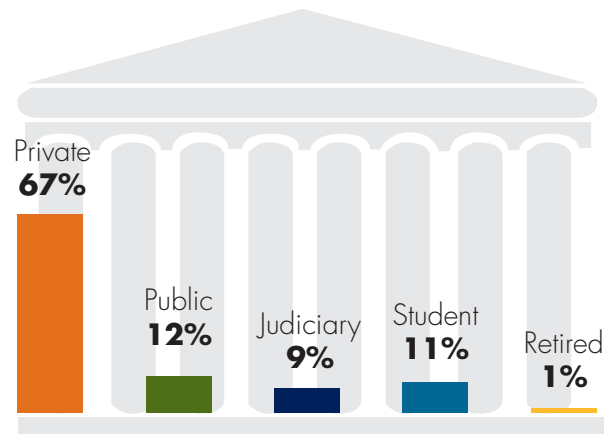

## Gender

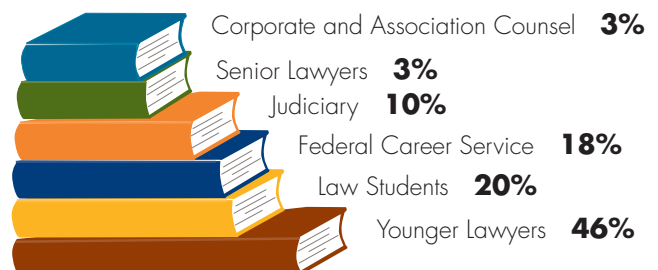


## Types of Practice

\*Percentage of all division memberships

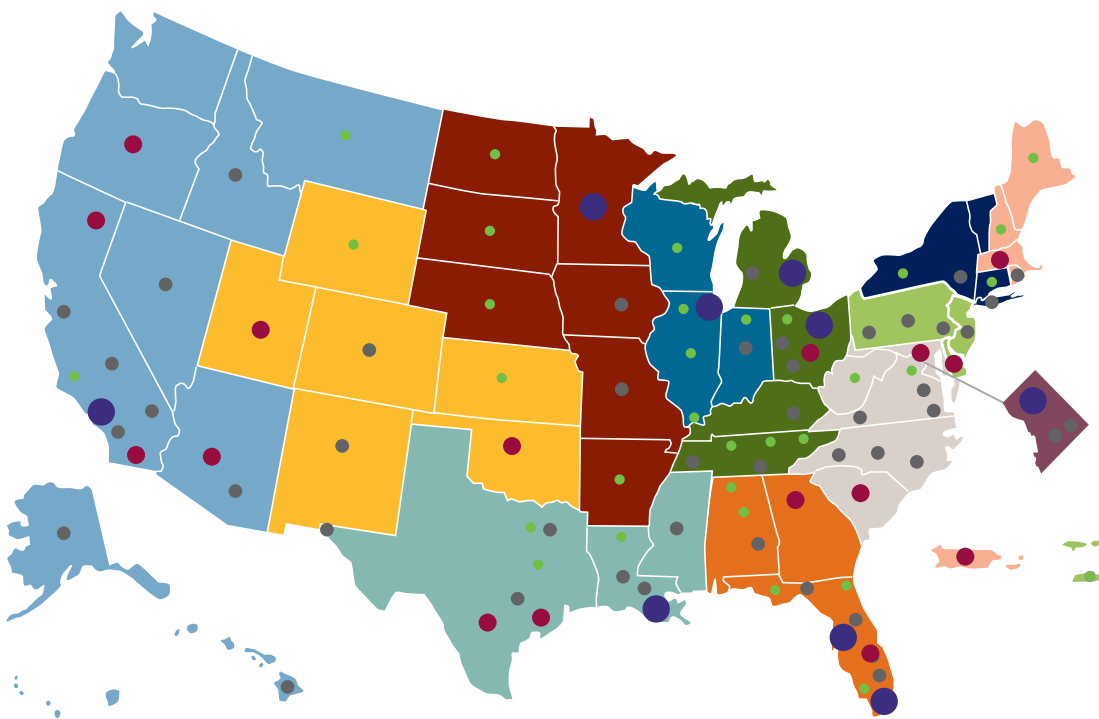

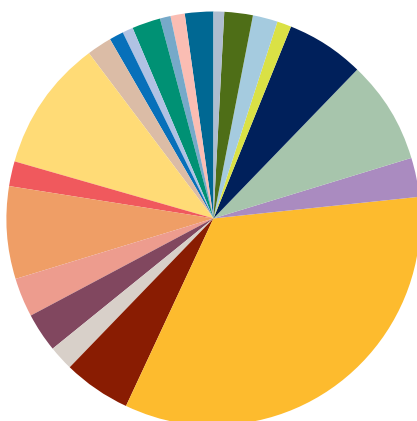

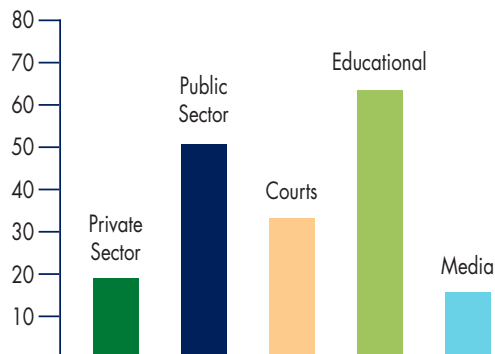

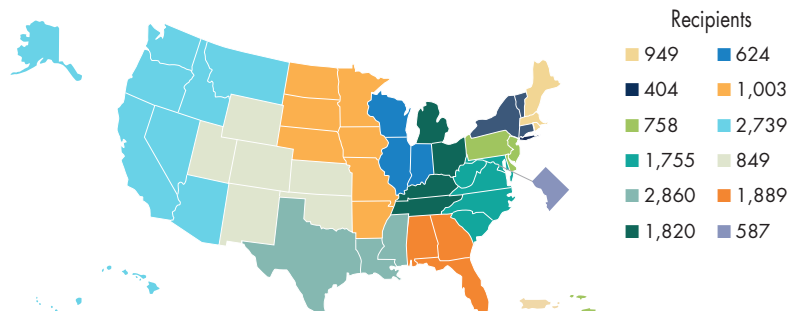
