The scholarship will offer:

- \$230 scholarships will decrease the registration fee to \$325.00 per individual
- Two full days of CLE sessions
- Tickets to lunch on Thursday and Friday
- Ticket to the Thursday night Reception

Recipients will be responsible for lodging accommodations, transportation, meals not listed, and personal expenses.

Application Requirements:

- Applicants must be involved in Indian law issues through law practice, governmental agencies, or educational institutions.
- Applicants must describe (in 1 to 3 paragraphs) their reasons for being interested in the Indian Law conference and for wanting to attend the Indian law conference. This should be in a Microsoft Word or PDF format.
- Applicants must demonstrate financial need for the reduced conference registration rate

Involvement with the Federal Bar Association, FBA Indian Law Section and the Indian Law conferences will be considered and highly regarded.

Additional Information:

Only fully completed applications will be considered. No applications will be returned. All decisions of the selection committee will be final. No more than 50 scholarship recipients will be selected. The selection committee consists of three Federal Bar Association members involved in the Indian Law section.
