THE PROGRAM

This full day program will consist of a series of workshops exploring the numerous difficult issues presented by the *Vitro* decision in particular, and Chapter 15 practice in general. Participants will include international attorneys and others attending the 50th Annual Academy of American and International Law*, as well as U.S. based insolvency practitioners. All attendees will be divided into working groups of approximately 20 people each, and discussions will be led by panels of distinguished judges and practitioners.
