- Business card clearly stating affiliation with a news organization as specified and position, e.g., editor, publisher, writer, reporter, producer, etc.
- Letter on official letterhead from the editor of a publication/website or producer of a broadcast program certifying the affiliation, verifying assignment to the meeting, and including the editor's contact information

Please note the following guidelines and restrictions:

- Press are not to consume food or beverage—you are responsible for bringing (or purchasing) your own breakfast and lunch while onsite.
- Following the conference, the FBA may have access to all published media content and photos taken at the conference.
- Video recording of sessions is prohibited, and speakers generally are not available for interviews. Please be mindful of speakers' time and privacy.
