**About the Webinar:**

The ILS Younger Lawyers Division and Diversity Committees are thrilled to invite you to participate in their webinar on Immigration Relief for Minors. Presented by Abbie Johnson is the Managing Attorney of RMIAN's Children's Program and Elizabeth Badger a Senior Attorney with Kids in Need of Defense, this panel will cover legal relief options for immigrant children who are in removal/deportation proceedings and for those children not appearing in front of the immigration court. The Panelists will discuss Special Immigrant Juvenile Status (SIJS), including the particular issues children may face in the State court proceedings, in front of the immigration court, and during adjudication interviews with U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS). In addition, the Panelists will discuss other common forms of immigration status options for children such as Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA), U Nonimmigrant Status (the "U Visa") for victims of crime, T Nonimmigrant Status (the "T Visa") for victims of human trafficking, and asylum law as it applies to children. The Panelists will also share tips on communicating and working with a child client.
