APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION TO THE BAR

Instructions: Only attorneys admitted to the bar of the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit may practice before the Court. In accordance with Fourth Circuit Rule 46(b), an attorney who is admitted to practice before the highest court of a state and who is of good moral and professional character may become a member of the bar. Candidates for admission at the September 16, 2022, Charleston, SC admission session should follow these instructions:

1. Complete the form and sign the oath.
2. Mail the completed form and the admission fee of \$228 (by check payable to "Clerk, United States Court of Appeals") to the Clerk of the United States Court of Appeals, 1100 E. Main Street, Suite 501, Richmond, VA 23219-3517. The form and fee should be received by the Clerk's Office no later than September 9, 2022.
3. Appear in the Sol Blatt, Jr. Courtroom, 83 Meeting Street, Charleston, SC on September 16, 2022, for admission in open court following conclusion of oral arguments (between 2:30 p.m. and 3:30 p.m.).
