Policy No. 1-3: Uniform Policy on the Conferring of FBA National Awards

Policy:

The management of each FBA national award shall be the ultimate responsibility of the FBA Board of Directors. Each FBA national award shall be conferred based upon criteria that are approved by the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors, in evaluating and approving the criteria, will consider the extent to which conferring of the awards will further the goals and purposes of the Federal Bar Association.

The award criteria should include a description of each of the following: the name of the award, the amount of the award, its purpose, the process by which the awards recipient is to be selected, including the appointment of committee members, the anticipated duration of the award, a description of the event at which the award is to be conferred, and the expected source of funding for the award.

Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to establish a uniform policy governing the conferring of FBA National Awards.
