Advocacy Update

As the 118th Congress begins its work, the FBA is assessing its policy goals and planning advocacy efforts, taking into account the new congressional landscape and leadership priorities. Planning for Capitol Hill day – March 23 – is underway, and an introductory webinar is scheduled for January 24 at 3pm ET.

Legislative Update

1. Article I Immigration Court Legislation

We are hopeful that Rep. Zoe Lofgren (D-CA), will re-file the Real Courts, Rule of Law Act in the new Congress, and we anticipate renewing the FBA's support for that legislation in the House, as well as continuing to encourage the introduction of a Senate companion bill to establish a new Immigration Court. FBA will continue to work with a variety of stakeholders in an informal coalition of supporters for this policy proposal. In the event that in this Congress, there is a greater interest in tackling immigration policy generally, FBA will be working to ensure that this concept of an immigration court is part of that debate.

2. FY 2024 Appropriations for the Judiciary

The Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts (AO) will be submitting its funding request for Fiscal Year 2024 in the first quarter of 2023, and the FBA will support fully funding that request, as well as full funding for the Article I courts (Court of Appeals for the Armed Forces, Tax Court, and Veterans Court), and Department of Justice funding to implement the Daniel Anderl Judicial Security and Privacy Act.

3. Judgeships Legislation

The FBA will continue to support the addition of new judgeships to improve access to and the administration of justice in the federal legal system. We anticipate that sponsors of some of the judgeships bills filed last Congress will reintroduce their bills after the Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts releases its 2022 annual report with updated recommendations regarding the need for new seats on the federal bench. FBA has already contacted senior staff for the sponsors and expects to assist in the development and marketing of the bills.



Judiciary Updates

<u>Ninety-nine</u> of President Biden's judicial nominees were confirmed in the 117th Congress. <u>Eighty-seven</u> of 890 active federal judicial positions, including the United States Court of Federal Claims and the United States territorial courts, are currently vacant. Twenty-six more judicial vacancies are <u>expected</u> through the end of 2023, with five nominees named in advance.

There are twenty-eight judicial vacancy emergencies, based on caseload and/or the length of the vacancy, according to the Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts, including one in the 5th Circuit and one in the 11th Circuit.

Judicial Confirmations: No judges have yet been confirmed by the 118th Congress.
