## 5 Steps for FBA Chapters to Adopt the Judicial Intern Academy:

- 1** Determine which accredited law schools are in in your FBA Chapter's Judicial District
- 2** Communicate with the FBA Judiciary Division that your FBA Chapter is willing to adopt the Judicial Intern Academy  
  
The FBA Judiciary Division will work with each FBA Chapter to find a host judge in your district
- 3** Recruit former federal judicial law clerks to serve as Law Clerk Advisors (LCAs) and decide how many students to select per school (suggested 5-10 students)
- 4** Communicate with each law school through the career office, educate the school about the Judicial Intern Academy, and determine whether there exists an FBA law student chapter that can assist with informing fellow students
- 5** Establish a Chapter committee to annually:
  - provide the Judicial Intern Academy information each spring semester for dissemination
  - select students once applications are received
  - pair each student with recruited LCAs
  - work with host judge on programming
  - host meeting before internship begins in June
